


ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Beartooth Highway/U.S. 212

UPDATE FOR OCTOBER 11 TO OCTOBER 17, 2004

Just east of Cooke City, work includes excavation and culvert installation. There are short detours over packed gravel and rough road in isolated areas. **Just east of the Clay Butte Lookout turnout**, work includes tree clearing. The existing asphalt will be unaffected.

****WINTER ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION:** The Beartooth Pass closes the morning of October 12, prohibiting eastbound travel into Red Lodge on U.S. 212. Travel between Cooke City and Cody via WY 296 and U.S. 212 will be possible through November 7.



US 212 east of Cooke City to Wyoming State Line

Monday to Friday: Up to 30-minute delays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Monday to Thursday: Road closed nights from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
(no delays Saturday or Sunday)

US 212 west of Clay Butte Lookout turnoff to milepost 35

Monday to Saturday: Intermittent 30-minute delays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
(no delays Sunday)
