On new chip sealed surfaces, apply two coats. Apply the first coat at 107 square feet per gallon and the second coat at a rate of 107 square feet per gallon.

On new asphalt pavements or new asphalt surface treatments, apply two coats. Apply the first coat at 214 square feet per gallon and the second coat at a rate of 107 square feet per gallon. Do not use glass beads on the first coat.

Measurement

634.13 Delete the second paragraph and substitute the following:

When two coats of paint are required, measure the first coat only.

Delete the first sentence of the third paragraph and substitute the following:

Measure all painted centerlines, including solid and broken, edge lines, crosswalks, and parking lot striping by the linear foot. Measure the length of line applied along the centerline of each 4-inch-wide line applied regardless of color.

Do not measure the PMP for payment. The PMP is considered subsidiary to the paint item.

Section 635. - TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL

635.01 Add the following to the end of the first paragraph:

This work also consists of minor traffic control to block staging and construction equipment parking areas and road closure barriers.

635.07 Construction Signs. Delete the Subsection and substitute the following:

Use type III, IV, VIII, IX, or XI retroreflective sheeting. For roll-up signs, use type VI retroreflective sheeting. Remove or completely cover all unnecessary signs with an acceptable material. Acceptable materials include plywood, hardboard, sheet metal, aluminum, corrugated polypropylene board, or rigid plastic, durable enough to resist deterioration due to weathering and atmospheric conditions for the duration of the project. Do not use adhesives, glues, tapes, or mechanical fasteners that mar the face of the panel to be masked.

Provide the same type of sheeting on all post-mounted construction signs that pertain to the project.

Use crashworthy posts within the traversable area adjacent to traffic. Install posts according to Section 633.

635.09 Flaggers. Delete the Subsection and substitute the following:

Use flaggers certified by the American Traffic Safety Services Association, the National Safety Council, the International Municipal Signal Association, a state agency, or other acceptable
