

Albright Curve

The “Albright Curve” area is the easternmost set of switchbacks on the Wyoming portion of the highway. Several wetlands and fens are found in the area. Some of the wetlands contain rare plants. FHWA developed three options for the area, which vary by the turning radius of the switchbacks.

Existing Alignment Option

- Most closely follows the existing alignment.
- Has a design speed of 30 km/h (19 mph).
- Is a design speed exception.

Option A

- Has a design speed of 50 km/h (31 mph).

Option B

- Has a design speed of 40 km/h (25 mph).
- Is a design speed exception.
